

Idea builds into a robust reality

GIPPSLAND'S Matt Phelan didn't lose his home in the 2007 Black Saturday fires.

But it convinced him that his new business idea would work.

At the time of the devastating fires, which claimed 173 human lives, the Hazelwood North resident and his brother, Marcus, had spent three years researching an idea to build concrete homes which could survive Australian bushfires.

In an Australian-first they have pioneered a home building system with their company Refuge Homes, which has the highest fire resistance — or flame-zone rating — and is virtually cyclone proof.

The company offers a number of pre-designed homes built from a concrete pour system they developed.

Matt said the houses, including a display home at Hazelwood North, feature concrete roofs, a very high energy rating and are affordable.

"One of the biggest building costs is labour so we wanted to be able to build the house quickly and efficiently," Matt said.

The idea came from the brothers' extensive experience in the construction business.

The brothers' research included a trip to the US tornado belt to look at building systems

"By the time Black Saturday happened, we were well into our research, but that prompted a different approach," Matt said. "We took advice from fire engineers and structural engineers on how to put it together to withstand a tree falling on it."
